



Please ensure you have done the following after arriving in Adelaide:

- Phone Home – *your friends and family will be eager to hear that you have arrived in Adelaide safely!*
- Rest and drink plenty of water
- Read the following sections of your arrival pocket guide (you will get this at the airport if you have booked the Arrival Service):
 - Hints on your first 72 hours in Adelaide
 - A list of places to visit in the city
 - A list of places to buy food, medicine, and toiletries
 - A list of useful phone numbers
- Visit Ask Adelaide (on Level 3 of Hub Central) to receive a Student Guide and any Orientation information that you may have missed
- Get to know the local area
- Take a walk to find your closest shops and transport stops

- Make a plan to find your long term accommodation if you are in short term / temporary accommodation
- Set up your Australian bank account - you will need to take your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) or student card, as well as identity documents, to do this
